Veronika Gerber, Violin

Born in Weiden i.d.OPf, the violinist Veronika Gerber received her first violin lessons at the Franz Grothe Municipal Music School. From the age of 16, she was taught by Max Speermann (HfM Würzburg).

Two years later, Veronika Gerber took up artistic violin studies at the University of Music Würzburg in Prof. Klaus Lieb's violin class and successfully completed them.

In addition to her studies, Veronika Gerber regularly attends master classes with Prof. Roland Daugareil (Paris), Prof. Cecilia Zilliakus (Stockholm) and Prof. Ingolf Turban (Munich), among others, for further musical, artistic and pedagogical training.

As part of orchestras such as the „Junge Deutsche Philharmonie“, the „Galina Chamber Ensemble“ and various festival orchestras, the young violinist has performed throughout Europe under conductors such as Dennis Russel Davis, Peter Leipold and Jukka-Pekka Saraste.

As a musician, Veronika Gerber attaches particular importance to moderated concert formats, which give her the opportunity to share her love of classical music with the audience and thus actively contribute to cultural mediation.
